Resistance class DIN V ENV 1627 - (DIN 18103)	Burglar type
WK 1	Burglar without professional tools He will try to open the locked door at first by a simple way: kicking and with his shoulder
WK 2 - (ET 1)	Like resistance class ET 1: The burglar will use in simple tools to try open the door.
WK 3 - (ET 2)	Like resistance class ET 2: Experienced burglar will use professional tools use to try to open the door like hammer, screwdriver, steel lift equipment etc. Note: No electrical equipment
WK 4 - (ET 3)	Like resistance class ET 3: Experienced burglar will use professional tools use to try to open the door like electrical tools and axe, screwdriver, hammer and also an accu - drill machine
